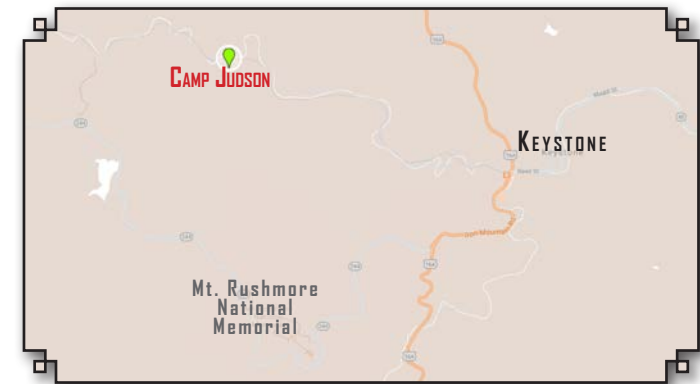


CAMPS FARTHEST OUT (CFO)

This is a family camp minutes from Mt. Rushmore.
