

# Welcome to St. Benedict Center!

Many of the things we love about our Center have stayed the same but here are some things that have changed for the time being.

Please be aware of these possible covid symptoms and stay home if you have had any of them in the last 14 days or been exposed to someone with them.

- Fever greater than 100
- Difficulty breathing
- Dry cough
- Loss of sense of taste or smell

***While we love to see our guests return, please err on the side of caution if you aren't feeling well and stay home.***

**Guests are asked to wear face masks in all public areas of the Center.** We currently encourage, but don't require hosted groups to wear masks in their conference room.

Guests are not allowed to share a bedroom unless they live in the same household.

Chairs in the conference rooms are spaced apart for social distancing. Please sit in the same chair throughout the conference you are attending.

The Chapel is set up for social distancing. Please leave as is.

The Solarium (library) and the outside areas may be used at each guest's discretion.

Regarding Food Service:

- The buffet is self-serve, however, only one side of the buffet will be available for guest use.
- 6 ft. social distancing is required while in line and hand sanitizer is available in both the buffet and beverage station areas.
- Silverware is wrapped and buffet items have more space between them.

The dining room is also spaced apart for social distancing. Please leave chairs as is. If you are here on a busier weekend, we may reserve tables and ask your group to sit at the same table throughout your stay.

Disinfectant wipes are available near the front door to clean the handles of our carts and wagons before/after use.

Our housekeeping staff disinfects high use areas several times per day.

Please strip your bed when departing and place the sheets in the tubs provided in the hallway.

Prayer and Mass times held in the chapel at Christ the King Priory are closed to the public.
