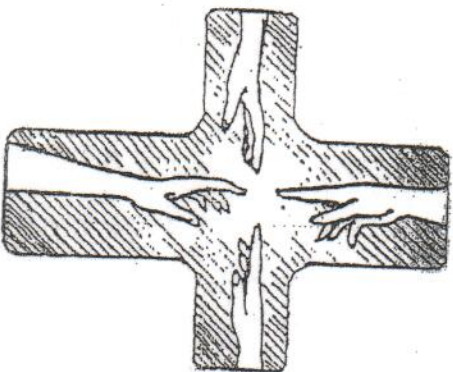
What is CFO?

CFO is a prayer-filled environment where we discover and share God's kingdom in the midst of today's world. Founder Glenn Clark, a college professor and coach, said, "the Camps Farthest Out are dedicated to the purpose of discovering the wholeness of that abundant life which Christ promised, that life which is our rightful heritage whenever we dedicate our body, mind and worship. We invite our campers to enter the kindergarten of creativity and discover all the joyous opportunities for normal spiritual expression. . . the highest art of life is a living prayer."

Prayer is a foundation of CFO: silent prayer, spoken prayer, individual prayer, and group prayer. Because we have learned that God truly answers prayer, we take our concerns to Him.

CFO is Christ-centered and non-denominational; campers are encouraged to faithfulness in the church of their choice. Theological differences are laid aside, allowing harmony and the love of God to manifest itself among us. There is no organization to join; rather, we are a living organism with the goal of growth through the development of our personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

The name "Camps Farthest Out" was chosen over 80 years ago as Glenn Clark was vacationing on Monhegan Island, the island farthest out off the coast of Maine. He envisioned "farthest out" as symbolic of going "all the way" with God and the laws of His kingdom as "Athletes of the Spirit". CFO camps and retreats meet in various countries around the world, and are intergenerational as well as interdenominational.

Trucked away on four acres of land in a peaceful, quiet rural setting of natural beauty in the hill country of northwest Connecticut, **the Oratory of the Little Way** is a Christian retreat and healing center welcoming individuals and groups of all denominations and backgrounds to come away for times of prayer and spiritual renewal.

All CFO Day activities will occur on the ground floor; optional furnished overnight accommodations for guests coming from afar are upstairs for a donation to the Oratory of the Little Way.

DIRECTIONS:

From the west / New York state: take I-84 east into Connecticut to Exit 7 (Left exit) onto US Route 7 North / US Route 202 East. Go 19 miles. At a firehouse with a red roof, turn right onto South Kent Road. In a few feet, bear left to stay on South Kent Road. The driveway for Oratory Lane is 0.4 miles on the right.

From the east / Waterbury, Connecticut: take I-84 West to Exit 7. Proceed on US Route 7 North as above.

From the south: take I-287 to Saw Mill Parkway north to I-684 north to I-84 east into Connecticut to Exit 7. Proceed to the Oratory as above.

From the north: The Oratory is 18 miles south of Cornwall, Connecticut via US Route 7.
